The Project's Aim

The project's main aim is to reinforce crosssectoral cooperation with a focus on creativity, cultural awareness, active participation of youth in the society and to youth workers, support artists, and policymakers find creative and to innovative solutions to the new challenges that the Covid-19 crisis has brought. The Building Better project targets organizations, organizations active in the field of arts and culture. institutions and local authorities Germany, Cyprus, Italy, and Greece.



Expected Results

The Building Better consortium is going to develop two Project Results, which aim to support young people's well-being and enhance their societal resilience, social inclusion, and participation. These two Project Results are the following:

- 1) A Webinar which aims to provide local policymakers, youth workers, artists, and representatives of the Cultural and Creative Sectors with knowledge and skills on how to face challenges, share ideas and practices as well as find opportunities to work together on collective resources and campaigns in order to engage youth in cultural activities and the CCSs in the age of social distancing.
- 2) An Online Portal of Cooperation through which local policymakers, workers and practitioners working in the youth work field, as well as young people and artists can enter and receive information on how they can be more active and support young people and other to face the variety of challenges arising from coronavirus crisis. The online platform will include different resources and tools based on each of the above profiles and will also include a participatory space where each user will have the opportunity to share their initiatives, experiences, challenges, and solutions.

Eurosuccess is in the process of embedding the content of the Webinar in EN into the online learning environment.


